



City of Wayzata Public Hearing Notice

Zoning Ordinance Amendment – Solar Ordinance, Chapter 902, and Chapter 909

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Wayzata Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider a Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment that creates a new Chapter in the Wayzata City Code – Chapter 938 Solar Ordinance. The proposed Solar Ordinance would regulate all solar energy system installations in the city. Currently, there are no specific regulations for solar energy systems in the City Code. The public hearing will also consider minor Zoning Ordinance Amendments to Chapter 902 – Rules and Regulations, and Chapter 909 – Design Standards. The goal is to provide clarity regarding the installations of solar energy systems to residents and applicants while ensuring the systems fit the goals and character of the Wayzata community.

The Planning Commission public hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, January 4, 2023 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter in the Wayzata Community Room, 600 Rice Street East, Wayzata, Minnesota. The Planning Commission meeting will be conducted in a hybrid manner that will allow for the public to attend remotely. Your public comments may be sent via email to PublicComment@wayzata.org.
