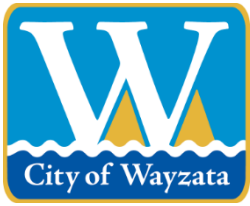

DISCUSSION OBJECTIVE:

To receive an update and ask questions regarding public safety initiatives for Summer of 2023.

BACKGROUND:

As a seasonal destination with increased visitor activity over the past several years, City departments, led by the Police Department, have adapted to the changing and increased service demand in order to keep residents, businesses, and visitors safe. Last year, in conjunction with the Panoway District Committee, the Police Department led several initiatives that targeted several reoccurring public safety related concerns. Examples of those initiatives include hiring more police officers for increased presence, installation of flock cameras, adding noise ordinance signage, and exploring access control at the Mill Street Parking Ramp.

Chief Schultz will provide a verbal update of expected activity, what the priorities will be for this year, and answer questions from the Council.
